McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

What's a Vruchten?

Today's opening hymn was a new one for our congregation, "This Joyful Eastertide." It is a classic Dutch hymn titled, "Vruchten," which means "fruits," or more aptly, the part of the fruit that contains the seeds, in Dutch. The text was written by British hymn-writer George R Woodward back in 1894 to fit the beloved Dutch tune.

The first two phrases are identical, providing stepwise motion and closes with a 'melisma' on the final word, where multiple notes are sung on one syllable. This gives way to the refrain which carries on the general motive of the first phrase in simple stepwise motion, acting like a scale of sorts and carrying us up and down the staff in gentle melodic fashion. The refrain concludes with the most notable feature of this hymn, which is the use of 'text painting'-- where the musical notes represent the word they carry, on the word, "arisen." Each time we sing 'arisen,' the music goes up a little bit more, until we come to the climax tone and sing the final melisma that mimics the first two melismas we sing during the verses.

These and many more musical elements are the sorts of things I study when considering 'new' hymns for our parish to sing. In my estimation, the metrical form of hymnody that permeates our weekly liturgies has given us a consistent form of congregational singing that has boosted the confidence and volume of our parish in song. To that end: thank you for participating in the music we sing at Mass each week. It is a gift to hear the voices of our parish unite in prayer each and every week!

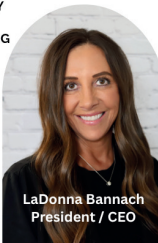

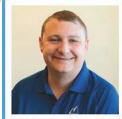

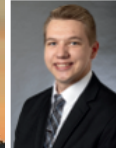
