CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

The Bible

Sarah Bofferding, Director of Catechesis

The Bible can be intimidating to introduce to children, as we often are unfamiliar with it ourselves!

Here are a few ways to lift up this most Holy book and instill in children a reverence and love for God's words to us:

1. **Give the Bible a place of honor** – set it on a beautiful cushion or book stand on a shelf or table accessible to children, so they can see it and use it!
2. **Read it together** – Announce that they are going to hear your voice, but that these are God's words to them. Small verses and stories from the Gospels are a great way to start, like John 8:12 *"Jesus said, I am the Light of the world."*
3. **Handling the Bible** – Show the child how to carefully hold and reverence the Bible with a kiss, like Father or the Deacon does at Mass!

In February 2027, twenty-three members of Sts. Anne & Joachim Catholic Church will board a plane and begin a journey of faith and service to Chimbote, Peru. This mission trip is an opportunity for our parish to put faith into action by serving alongside our brothers and sisters in Chimbote.

Support the Mission

Our goal is to raise **\$40,000** to support the Sts. Anne & Joachim Chimbote mission projects. Every gift, no matter the size, will help bring hope and practical assistance to the people our parish will serve. The funds raised will directly support life-changing projects, including building, painting, and furnishing three homes; providing food and clean water to hundreds of people; and funding a social worker for one year.

Thanks to the generosity of Sts. Anne & Joachim parishioners, mission participants will also distribute 214 backpacks, along with additional school supplies, Spanish Bibles, and storybooks for school-age children.

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing

"Come, thou fount of every blessing, tune my heart to sing thy praise!" This well-known line from today's opening hymn is a perfect way to start Mass on Sunday, as we praise the Lord, our God, from whom we receive all blessings!

The author of this hymn is a British fellow by the name of Robert Robinson. He wrote this hymn, "*Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing*" as a pairing with a sermon he prepared for Pentecost Sunday. He wrote it as a prayer that the Holy Spirit might come into our hearts with 'streams of mercy,' encouraging us in faithfulness to God's commands and to praise him.

This hymn has been published in nearly 2500 hymnals since it was first penned in the year 1758. Popularity is not an indicator of truth of course, but the popularity this hymn enjoys is a sure indication that something is stirred up in the singer quite effectively if English hymn publishers have continued to feature it for nearly 300 years!

In the midst of some personal research this summer, I learned that only 2 Catholic hymnals maintain this hymn today, one of them being our own Source & Summit Missal. For that, I am quite thankful!
