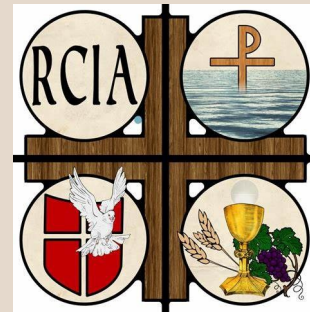

## McChoir's *Music* Corner

### June 16th – 11th Sunday In Ordinary Time

"I Want To Walk as a Child of the Light" is a great example of a modern hymn. By modern, we're talking about anything written in the last 100 years or so (not the same metric for cars or phones when talking about music!), and this was written back in 1966 by Kathleen Thomerson. She is retired now, and enjoyed an impressive career as a church musician, serving multiple congregations of different faith backgrounds, and studying organ with some of the great masters of the modern era. Her contribution of this hymn tune & text have nourished many Christians in worship, having been published in 40 different hymnals spread throughout thousands of churches. But we don't know her name like we know popular artists like Taylor Swift, Ed Sheeran, Charlie Puth, or any other number of the great artists of our day. As I think about it now, I have a small yearning to learn about the church musicians whose music has added delight to my prayer. Perhaps I'll take a moment to say a prayer of thanksgiving that God has used them and their talents to benefit me and my own prayer life.

### Can you spend an hour with ME?

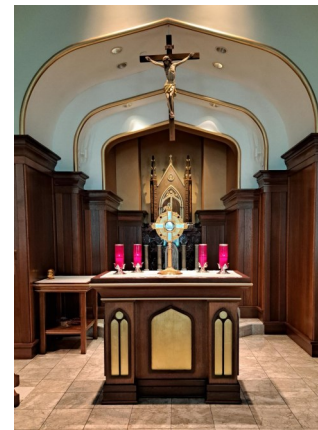
