
### STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

### McChoir's Music Corner

June 9th – 10th Sunday In Ordinary Time

What makes a melody “good?” Though there is sure to be scholarly debate and stylistic preference, let’s venture into this idea. For our purposes in worship, a good melody is relatively singable, and usually maintains some kind of rhythmic pattern with logical syllabification. For example, today’s responsorial psalm was “with the Lord there is mercy, and fullness of redemption.” Try saying the psalm out loud, and notice that you naturally go faster on words like ‘the,’ and ‘there is,’ but you slow down a little on words like ‘Lord,’ ‘mercy,’ and ‘redemption.’ The music does a pretty good job reflecting that natural speech pattern, and that is a commonality for lots of good music out there. If the syllables get emphasized in an unnatural way, it feels weird to sing or speak it. Add on the use of only 4 unique pitches in this refrain, and we’re set up for success as a congregation, we can participate with this no problem! This is just a glimpse into the analytical approach I take to music selection on a regular basis for our parish, and also happens to be the subject matter for my Master’s Thesis as well. I like breaking music down to see what is technically happening, and then use the information to help me decide on music selections each week. It sure is geeky, but I really enjoy this process!

## Can you spend an hour with ME?

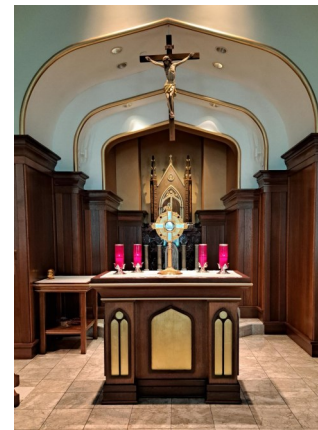
