McChoir's Music Corner

July 14th – 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's gospel passage highlights the 12 apostles being sent on mission, to which "Go Make of All Disciples" is a fitting pairing as an offertory hymn today. Here we see an example of music that echoes the message of the readings, fitting to the theme of scripture in the 3-year cycle (We are currently in year B of this cycle). The communion antiphon, and all the antiphons for that matter, do not follow this a 3-year cycle. As such, the communion antiphon for the 15th

Sunday in Ordinary time is always the same: "The sparrow finds a home, and the swallow a nest for her young: by your altars, O Lord of hosts, my king and my God. Blessed are they who dwell in your house, forever singing your praise." (*Psalms 84*) Because of this, our communion hymn was "Jerusalem, My Happy Home." These two hymns have different emphases, but they both work quite well in their respective places to echo the message from today's Gospel, and accompany in theme the content of the communion antiphon.

Bishop Folda invites the people of the Diocese of Fargo to join him at the Jamestown Civic Center on September 6-7 for the Redeemed Eucharistic Congress. This two-day Eucharistic event will serve as the local diocesan launch of the National Eucharistic Revival's Year of Mission. An impressive slate of speakers such as Dr. Scott Hahn, Julianne Stanz, and Msgr. Thomas Richter will usher us deep into an encounter with Our Eucharistic Lord so that we can bring Jesus Christ out into the world.

In addition to powerful presentations, the Congress will begin with a Eucharistic procession from St. James Basilica to the Jamestown Civic Center and will feature Holy Mass with Bishop Folda, Eucharistic Adoration, opportunities for confession, and a Eucharistic healing service. This is a chance for the people of our diocese to come together in worship of Christ the Lord as we beg for an outpouring of grace and renewal in our area. 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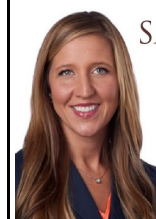
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
