Calling all Catholic Men

McChoir's Music Corner

July 21st – 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Psalm 23 is undoubtedly one of the most well-known psalms out there, and it is our responsorial psalm today. "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want." I play this particular melody by Owen Alstott over and over again in various contexts. There is a special comfort that we all seem to relate to when it comes to the pastoral text this psalm contains. Our full slate of readings today references the analogy to Jesus Christ the Good Shepherd. I don't think any force could make me resist then, the delightful Irish melody ST COLUMBA to the text "The King of Love My Shepherd Is." The author of the text is Henry W. Baker, a 19th-Century Anglican priest and co-editor of one of the most famous historical hymnals, *Hymns Ancient and Modern (1861)*. Within this hymn, Baker ties together Psalm 23 with Matthew 18:10-14 which recounts the Parable of the Lost Sheep, and John 10 telling the account of The Good Shepherd, which is understood to be Christ who "is the gate for the sheep." (Jn 10:7) I can't think of many lines that have been crafted so beautifully as the last verse that Baker penned, "And so through all the length of days, Your goodness fails me never: Good Shepherd, may I sing your praise, Within your house forever."
