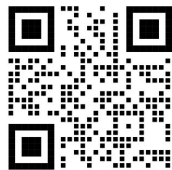

CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Ordinary Time

The weeks of Ordinary Time before Lent are a gift. While they may seem quiet or unremarkable, the Church calls them “ordinary” because they are *ordered* toward growth. This season invites families to deepen habits of faith through steady, faithful practice—much like a plant quietly putting down roots before a season of change.

In the Domestic Church, this is a beautiful time to focus on simple rhythms: Sunday Mass, daily prayer, kindness in ordinary moments, and faithfulness in small responsibilities. Green, the color of Ordinary Time, reminds us that discipleship grows gradually through consistency rather than intensity.

Before Lent begins, families might ask:

- **What habits are already helping our family grow closer to Jesus?**
- **What small practice could we strengthen?**

Whether it’s praying together before bed, reading a short scripture passage each week, or offering forgiveness more quickly, these ordinary acts prepare hearts for the deeper call of Lent.

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

When A Plan Comes Together

Anyone who has watched "The A-Team" knows the great line from Hannibal that marks many an episode, "I love it when a plan comes together." I sometimes think of this line as I read through the liturgical texts of the day, and see how the church has offered us something that really does tie together quite nicely.

Case in point: In today's first reading the prophet Isaiah declares that "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." We then sang "The Lord is my light and my salvation" from Psalm 27. Seeing this theme in our liturgical texts for the day, in addition to the call to mission in the Gospel reading, we see an intentional emphasis on the light of Christ. The light of Christ shines and spreads through all the world, and we are called to bear this light further, to all people, as we "go forth, glorifying the Lord by [y]our lives."

Bearing the light of Christ is what we mean when we sing the communion antiphon: "Look toward the Lord and be radiant; let your faces not be abashed." (Ps 34) We bask in the glow of the almighty God, and allow his radiance to warm us, or expose our lives in the brightness of his light. As we left today it was fitting to sing one of our parish's favorite hymns, "Be Thou My Vision," which includes this beautiful line: "Thou my best thought, by day or by night, Waking or Sleeping, thy presence my light."

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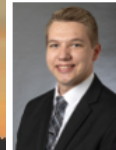


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
