CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The second-grade children of our parish have been diligently preparing and will soon receive a beautiful gift: the Father's mercy through their First Confession. For many of us, confession as children may have felt scary—motivated more by fear of punishment than by love. But it doesn't have to be that way for our children today.

Here are a few simple ways to foster a positive relationship with the Sacrament of Reconciliation and help reframe our image of God from one of fear to one of deep love and mercy:

- **Read and reflect on Scripture together.** Spend time with passages that reveal the heart of the Father, especially the parables of the Good Shepherd and the Lost Sheep.
- **Live forgiveness daily.** Model saying "I'm sorry" and "I forgive you," seek reconciliation within your family, and practice a simple daily or weekly family examen.
- **Go as a family.** Choose a regular time—perhaps once a month—to attend confession together, and end with a small celebration (ice cream comes to mind) to rejoice in the Lord's mercy.

These small practices help children encounter confession as a place of healing, love, and joy.

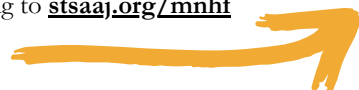

We have a plan on just how to do that.

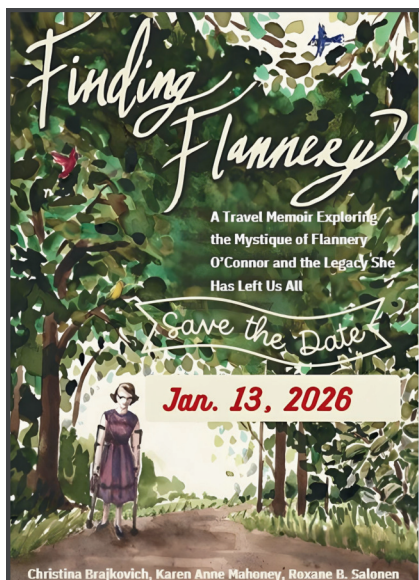

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Wait... is it still Christmas?

Today's feast falls into a little bit of confusion as the transition in our liturgical year from Christmas into Ordinary Time is defined by today's celebration. The Ordo says that "after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, Ordinary Time begins." Today is still decidedly within the Christmas season! At the same time, we fast forward from last week's Epiphany celebration where the Magi journeyed from the east to bring gifts to the child Jesus, and jump to 30 years later in today's Gospel passage where Jesus is baptized in the river Jordan by his cousin, John.

How do we bridge this gap? Though it might be strange to sing "O Come, All Ye Faithful" or "Silent Night" based on the scripture present in today's liturgy, it isn't out of the question to sing some more carols today! (If you were at the 9:15 Mass with the choir, you heard a couple!) Source & Summit has really smart people putting together their materials, and our opening hymn today was tailor-made for this liturgy: "When Jesus Comes to be Baptized." This is one of the office hymns for the Baptism of the Lord, and it presents the substance of today's liturgy beautifully. We also sang one of my favorite Christmas hymns, "Of the Father's Love Begotten," which we sang on Christmas day as well as today! The lyrics highlight the nature of Jesus as the Son of God, which is precisely what is revealed in today's Gospel. With that, we'll transition back to Ordinary Time and keep reflecting on the nature of Christ and all the mysteries of his ministry on earth. Merry Christmas once more!
