

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Mass Setting for Lent

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

In two weeks, Lent will begin; and with it, we will begin singing a new setting of the Ordinary. The Ordinary of the Mass are the texts that are 'ordinarily' sung at every Mass: the 'Kyrie' (*Lord Have Mercy*), 'Gloria' (*Glory to God*), 'Sanctus' (*Holy, Holy, Holy*), 'Mysterium Fidei' (*Mystery of Faith: 3 options – most common for us is 'We Proclaim Your Death'*), and 'Agnus Dei' (*Lamb of God*). The 'Credo' (*Creed*) is also a part of the Ordinary, but we'll save that for another day!

We have a cycle of Mass settings we have been working through over the past 4 years, and we tend to change at the beginning of a new liturgical season. The new setting we will sing in Lent is called "Missa Mater Dolorosa" by Fr. Michael O'Connor, O.P. I am very excited to begin singing this setting for a variety of reasons, too much to fit into this bulletin blurb!

So, to give you a full introduction (including a practice video to hear the music!) I have written a blog post on the parish website where you can go preview the music and get a feel for everything before we jump in on Ash Wednesday. 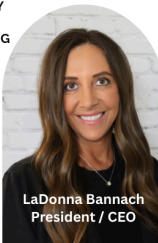

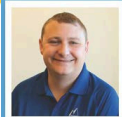
