PASTORAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS



The role of a Pastoral Council member is an important role in the parish family. The Church asks that each parish have a Pastoral Council made up of the lay faithful, over which the pastor presides, who can offer advice and assistance in fostering pastoral activity in the parish. It is a consultative voice for the pastor concerning any issues he brings to them from the parish, or any issues that they may bring to the pastor from the people in the parish.

The time commitment for the Pastoral Council includes five meetings per year, as well as some of the parish activities that take place each year, including the Block Party, Parish Feast Day Picnic and the Fall Festival. The term for a Council member is three years, and there is no second term for any member until at least a year has intervened since the last time on the Council. This ensures that the Council always has "new blood" and is reflective of the parish at the time as it changes grows itself. Three positions need to be filled this year and there is a total of nine members on our Pastoral Council.

Please consider whether you, or someone you know, might be a good person for this role.

Nominations will be taken after Masses on the weekend of February 21-22, with elections to be held two weeks later. In these upcoming days/weeks, you are encouraged to pray and ask our Lord if He is calling you-or someone you know-to serve our parish. Thank you for considering this opportunity!

CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Preparing our Hearts for Lent

The Church is once again entering a season of *preparation*, this time to prepare ourselves to celebrate the great feast, and season, of Easter. One beautiful tradition is the “burying” of the **Alleluia** before Ash Wednesday. Throughout the year, *Alleluia* (literally translated: “Praise the Lord”) is our joyful song of praise. During Lent, however, the Church sets it aside (buries it), creating space for longing and deeper preparation for Easter joy.

Children in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd are familiar with this concept, as they get to bury the alleluia each year in the Atrium before the season of Lent. This is a lovely tradition that can be lived in the Domestic Church, too! As a family, take time to write “Alleluia” on a small card, decorate it beautifully, and place it in a box or drawer until the Easter Vigil.

Lent is not meant to be gloomy, but purposeful. It is a season of quiet and listening, to prepare our hearts to celebrate with great joy at Easter!

Reflect as a family this week: What in our home can we gently set aside so our hearts are ready to sing “Alleluia” with even greater joy at Easter?

McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

Today is the last day we're going to hear "Alleluia" for awhile! In fact, in my places, there is a semi-formal ritual of 'burying the Alleluia' in preparation for Lent to begin--can you believe it is already that time of year!?

As for today's liturgy, I am delighted by the music of our communion change today. There is some really smart music composition happening here: 6 notes are used in this (relatively longer than usual) antiphon. The use of frequent stepwise motion, where each successive note is just one vertical space or line away from the previous, helps us to sing together with ease--even if we don't "know" the melody! It keeps things manageable for everyone in the pew to participate. I've often had people tell me, "Patrick, I can't read music," and I think there is some misconception about what that means.

Reading music doesn't mean you can pick up any song and just read it at sight with a high level of comprehension, it means you have a reference point on the page to pair with musical tones and words. I'll often say, "don't overthink it: when the notes go down, your voice goes down!" After that, you're just 'getting in the groove' with the cantor and the organist. It doesn't need to be super complex, and that is what these chants we are singing have been designed for.

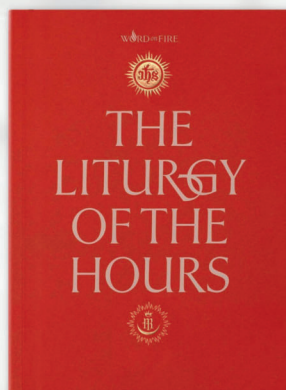

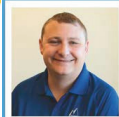
