CATECHESIS IN THE DOMESTIC CHURCH

Mercy at Home

On the Sunday after Easter, the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday**, revealing the heart of Jesus, full of love and mercy for the whole world. This devotion was entrusted to Saint Faustina Kowalska in the early 20th century, when Jesus asked that His mercy be proclaimed and a feast be established. Through her witness, the Church was reminded of the endless mercy flowing from Christ's pierced Heart!

At the center of this devotion is a simple prayer: **"Jesus, I trust in You."** These words can become the prayer and heartbeat of the Domestic Church. Consider falling back on this phrase when faced with frustrations and difficulties this week. Even if you don't feel like you're trusting Jesus, saying the words can help our hearts come into line with the truths that we proclaim!

One of the most powerful ways to model this trust is through the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**. When parents go to confession regularly, they show their children that God's mercy is real and always available.

Mercy received becomes mercy given, and this leads to the home becoming a place where trust in Jesus grows! I pray that your families encounter the mercy of our Lord in a new way this year!

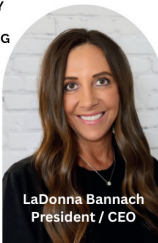

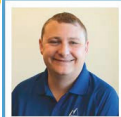

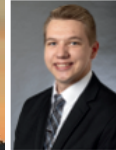
