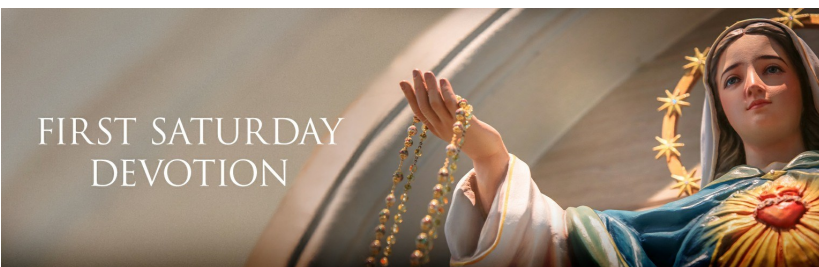

## McChoir's *Music* Corner

I think an important part of supporting the congregation to know hymns throughout the year, is to take advantage of opportunities to feature hymns that may otherwise only come on special feast days. For example, today's recessional was "To Jesus Christ, Our Sovereign King," and we might usually only hear that on Christ the King Sunday. If you only hear it once a year, it's harder to remember it and participate each time. I try to be conscious of that as I plan throughout the year, and give more opportunities to hear and participate with our congregational music. The text is based off of an 8th-century Latin text: "Christus vincit, Christus regnat, Christus imperat!" This is the basis of the refrain for the hymn: "Christ Jesus, victor! Christ Jesus, ruler! Christ Jesus, Lord and redeemer!" It is good not only for our learning purposes to sing this hymn, but it highlights a great truth of our Christian unity under the kingship of Jesus Christ our savior. That's worth belting out in this awesome refrain every chance we get!

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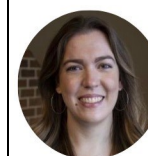
