McCHOIR'S MUSIC CORNER

A Humble Hymn of Prayer & Praise

Patrick McGuire, Director of Music

Today's communion hymn is very simple in structure, making it an easy meditation to ponder and pray with the words of Synesius of Cyrene (ca. 370-430AD), translated by Allen W. Chatfield (1808-1896). Synesius was an early bishop of the church at Ptolemais, in modern-day Libya. His prayer is centered around invoking the name of Jesus to "think on me," amidst many situations and difficulties that life presents in various forms.

This is a very humble prayer, that recognizes the need for being cleansed of the stain of sin, and seeks to be in heaven, where "I may the eternal brightness see, and share thy joy at last." In humility, we can all recognize places in our life where we can be cleansed and purified of sinful ways, and this prayer provides healthy wisdom to address such a thing.

There is something special about singing the words of a saint, or a former bishop of the church, particularly from the earliest days of the Church's existence in time. We have a unique connection as Catholics to those holy men and women who paved the way for what the Church has/had become. When we sing the words of an ancient bishop like Synesius, with a lovely metrical translation in English thanks to Allen Chatfield, another aspect of the 'catholic'—universal church unfolds to deepen our faith in a new way.
