# McChoir's Music Corner

(The Scrutiny Readings from the 9:15am Mass are different from what I reference in this corner)

Today's Communion antiphon is from John 12:24, found on pg. 88 of your Breaking Bread Missal: "Amen, amen, I say to you: Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains a single grain. But if it dies, it bears much fruit." This excerpt is also in the middle of today's Gospel; a great example of how the liturgy is connected across the Mass. It is very helpful to hear these texts multiple times to immerse us in God's word, especially with music! The cantor/choir sang the communion antiphon as part of our Lenten Communion Antiphon, and following that, we sang "Unless A Grain of Wheat" by Bernadette Farrell. The re-interpretation of some of the text from today's antiphon is clearly present in this song as well. As such, it is a nice pairing with the antiphon at communion time so we can meditate upon the words from today's Gospel and let that message sink in a little more.

No matter the circumstances, divorce always represents broken dreams and broken hearts. While LIFE-GIVING much of the attention goes to the men and women trying to navigate the tidal wave of loss and hurt, often left in the wake are the children whose sense of

security and identity have also been shattered. This can be true even for those who were already adults when their parents' relationship ended. Life-Giving Wounds is a new ministry within the Diocese of Fargo to help adults who have experienced the breakdown of their parents' relationship, no matter at what age it happened and to allow Christ to bring new life through those very wounds.


