




McChoir's Music Corner

4th Sunday of Easter

As we continue our Easter celebration, today is known as "Good Shepherd Sunday." We're reminded of our 'sheepfulness' in today's liturgy, knowing that we have a Good Shepherd to guide us, and that we depend completely upon Him. We sang "The King of Love, My Shepherd Is" and "Shepherd of Souls" for offertory and communion, respectively. The last verse of 'The King of Love' has always been a personal favorite: "And so through all the length of days your goodness fails me never: Good Shepherd may I sing your praise within your house forever." This puts further emphasis on the heavenly song of the angels and saints that we proclaim at each Mass: The 'Sanctus' ('Holy, Holy, Holy). At each Mass, the priest says the Preface of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, which ends indicating our union with the Powers of heaven when we sing. The Prefaces for Easter all end with: "Therefore, overcome with paschal joy, every land, every people exults in your praise and even the heavenly Powers, with the angelic hosts, sing together the unending hymn of your glory, as they acclaim..." Did you know that in heaven we get to sing this 'unending hymn of [His] glory'? In the offertory hymn, our prayer is to sing God's praises forever, as he is so good to us, the sheep of his flock. With that in mind, it's not a "baaaaaaaaad" idea to sing out whenever we have the opportunity! ('Ewe' will have to forgive me, I couldn't resist a good pun!)
